Hobby/Leisure Time Ideas to Do with Children

- Go outside on a pretty day and blow bubbles. Watch the child try to catch them.
- Show a child how to mend or sew on a button.
- Play a game of horseshoes.
- Buy two walkie talkies and have fun conversations.
- Play badminton using balloons.
- Watch a child play Frisbee with a dog, or go to the park and watch people playing with their pets.
- Make paper chains and decorate them with stickers.
- Play a game of hide-and-seek with each of you hiding a stuffed animal.
- Play marbles, jacks, or dominoes.
- Go to a pet store and look at the animals. Make up names for them.
- Play a game of balloon toss. Each time the balloon is caught, name a different color, animal, flower, etc.
- Put some boxes on the floor and assign them a point value of five, ten, fifteen, and twenty. Play beanbag toss and see how many points you can get after five turns.
- While riding in the car with a child, count the cars you see that are a certain color, or look for certain objects.
- Decorate sun visors for each other. Then wear them on a sunny day and go to the park.
- Put a hummingbird feeder outside in a place where you can easily watch the hummingbirds.
- Play charades. Try waltzing, playing baseball, fishing, playing cards, square dancing, etc.
- Make a bracelet or necklace by stringing together beads or buttons.
- Watch the sky on a partly cloudy day and see what shapes the clouds form.
- Draw large letters on each other's back or arm with a finger and try to guess what word was printed.
- Make puppets out of socks, and perform a skit.
- Play a board game together. Hold a tournament.
- Get some colored chalk and draw pictures on the driveway.
